Step One: Answer the Focus Question <u>"How did the event or person have an effect on the USA?"</u>

- Choose **one** topic to research: World Trade Center, Pentagon, Flight 93, or first responders to crisis situation

Step Two: Begin researching information about your selected topic. Use reliable sources (copy and paste your sources to your presentation).

Topic: World Trade Center (before 2001) Pentagon

Questions to answer:

- 1. Where is/was this building located? How many people worked there? Why is it important to the USA?
- 2. What happened to this building on Sept. 11, 2001? How many were injured?
- 3. What has happened to this building since 2001? Changes? Improvements? Memorials?
- 4. How do you think the events of Sept. 11th affected the American people? How do these events still affect the American people today?

Topic: Flight 93 first responders to a crisis

Questions to answer:

- 1. Describe how these people might be considered heroes. What did/do these people do?
- 2. Why are these people important to the events of Sept. 11, 2001? How many were injured?
- 3. What has happened to these people since 2001? Changes? Improvements? Memorials?
- 4. How do you think the events of Sept. 11th affected the American people? How do these events still affect the American people today?



Step Three: Create a display to share your information. Select one method:

- a ¾ full Google Doc page sharing pictures about the event/people; ¼ description of what is happening
- a keynote presentation with large pictures and several sentences describing what is happening
- a video presentation of yourself sharing the information that researched (2-3 minutes in length)
